#### Foreword

#### **Public submissions**

This Appendix contains 323 public submissions received by the Constitutional and Mainland Affairs Bureau and the Commission on Strategic Development from January 2004 to early July 2007. These submissions set out specific views relating to the attainment of the ultimate aim of selecting the Chief Executive and electing all the members of the Legislative Council by universal suffrage in accordance the Basic Law.

- 2. There are a number of submissions from senders who prefer to keep their views confidential or did not respond to our request for consent to publish the submissions. These submissions are not included in the Appendix.
- 3. The submissions are arranged, where possible, in chronological order of the date of submission.
