Dear the Correspondence,

It was a good thing for the Central Government in China to explain his position on the review on constitutional law in Hong Kong SAR. As most people say, the Central Government provide a clear platform for Hong Kong people to further discuss the issues.

However, there is still a group, whether they are in small size or a considerable size, who are totally opposite the explanation from Central Government. In their belief, they intend to fight for further independence. However, they may not realized that they are talking about absolute independence of Hong Kong, such as Taiwan. This create a big trouble. As a SAR, we can enjoy a high degree of independence but not total independence. At the end, that group will drive Hong Kong to a situation like Tibet.

Government should maintain a high degree of communication with all Hong Kong people to ensure the sovereign right of China over Hong Kong. If diplomatic approach fail, Chief Executive should consider to apply Cap575 Section 5 of the law of Hong Kong. Otherwise, the entrance of PLA into Tibet may re-occur in time as in history. Then, Hong Kong will be done.
