The following are the points submitted by Stephen C K Chan to the HKSAR Government for the political review.

1. The election committee of 800 members can be expanded to 250,000 selected by random draws from the some 2,500,000 registered voters. The nomination committee of the CE is to be composed by the directly elected Legco members.
2. The proportional representative system of the Legco election's geographical seats is to be replaced by the single seat simple majority system.
3. The electoral base of functional constituency seats can be expanded to include the entire working population
4. The Bill of Rights in HK – It seems that this Bill of Right of HK has been forgotten. It is time to put this Bill in the limelight again and to set up a Commission of Human Rights in HK and also to incorporate the Equal Opportunity Commission with it so that basic human rights as contained in the relevant International Covenant and equal opportunities can be protected and strengthened in HK while the safeguard of a democratic system is lacking.
5. Introduction of a Fair Trade Practice s Act – In order to promote fair trade practices and to prevent monopolistic acts, it is time for the government to introduce this long overdue Act to provide for a level playing field in the business world of HK. This Act should also apply to the directives and policies of the government itself.
