Subject: On Universal Suffrage

Dear the Correspondence,

As a progressive approach is taking, univesal suffrage on CE and Leg-co members should be separately coinsidered.

As the structure of Leg-co is quite mature, the univesal suffrage on Leg-co members can be conducted in year 2008. This can reduce some noise from the society. In addition, it is a good chance for Hong Kong citizens to get exercise and to see some result of their preception on democracy. Based on existing Leg-co structure, there in fact is little different from universal suffrage.

Unfortunately, Leg-co so far has little sense on equality of liberty, positive freedom and social moral. Those are three basic elements for democracy. Exercises can help them to understand themselves further.

If the Leg-co was under universal suffrage, government can continue to place bills and policies to leg-co; during the operation, by stressing on the argument about equality of liberty, positive freedom and social moral, even Hong Kong citizens would understand further on the meaning of democracy.

When everyone achieve a reasonable mark on those three elements, government can consider the universal suffrage on CE.

Finay, since the basic-law promised on the universal suffrage, government has to achi4eve it eventually, otherwise, HKSAR government and centra government would loss their creditability and trustworthiness.

P.S. On the definition of Leg-co in the Basic Law, without the precept on previous leg-co, the Leg-co in basic law may be referring to the joint council of previous Leg-co and district council. That means, District and Legislation councils should be merged to simplify the structure of HK SAR government. This can also reflect opinions of citizens more effectively.
