The Equal Opportunities (Sexual Orientation) Funding Scheme

BACKGROUND

The Equal Opportunities (Sexual Orientation) Funding Scheme (Funding Scheme) is an annual programme which started in 1998 to support worthwhile community projects that promote equal opportunities on ground of different sexual orientation.

 Any registered organization or sub-group of a registered organization may apply. The maximum sponsorship for each project will normally be \$100,000. The annual budget is usually around \$500,000.

5. In this financial year (2004/05), a total of \$550,000 has been

earmarked for the Funding Scheme. Out of the 10 applications received,

7 were approved with a total approved amount of about \$340,000.

There is a remaining sum of about \$210,000. Other than the funds

earmarked for the Funding Scheme, we also have \$117,000 available for

activities relating to promotion of equal opportunities on the ground of

sexual orientation.

We would like to develop worthwhile activities for the promotion

of equal opportunities on the ground of sexual orientation by making best

use of the total available amount of \$327,000. The forum could provide

resourceful ideas in this regard.
