- (\*) According to section 12(19A) of the Schedule to the CEEO as amended in the Bill, the specified entity of the subsector concerned is eligible to be registered as a corporate voter for that subsector only if it has been operating as such a specified entity for the 3 years immediately before making its application for registration as a voter.
